Our Radiation Therapists work closely with oncologists, physicists, nurses, patients, and patients' families. They navigate highly technical equipment while delivering precise, empathetic, and patient-centered care. Candidates accepted to the Saint John School of Radiation Therapy will have the opportunity to work and learn side by side with the radiation therapy health care team.

We offer a small center learning experience with advanced equipment and techniques. You will be given the opportunity for hands on learning in all aspects of cancer care. You will also be given several opportunities for inter-professional education and exposure to advanced radiation therapy techniques such as brachytherapy, SBRT and SRS.

At the SJ School of Radiation Therapy we welcome students from across Canada. The successful candidates will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- *Be highly motivated to participate and learn*
- *Show a sincere interest in health care at the interview*
- *Have a minimum average of B-*
- *Have been offered an interview from the Michener Institute/University of Toronto*
